

3D Durham Coast Cricket League

Junior Divisions

Under 15s Match Arrangements.

- A All points must be played for
- B Teams will not be allowed to forfeit points
- C All non fulfilled fixtures will be reported to the League Executive
- D All non returned, incomplete, or late result sheets will receive an imposed fine
- E All fixtures will be played as indicated and on the date appointed in the League handbook except in exceptional circumstances, whereby permission has been sought and granted by the Junior League Coordinator
- F Umpiring of fixtures must be done by an adult and
- G All junior players **must** be registered with the League, (statistical officer) prior to the first match of the season.
- H Players transferring from one club to another must completed a transfer request form. This document must lodged with the Junior League Coordinator **five days** before the player can take the field for his/her new club
- I At the conclusion of each fixture Captains must complete their nominations of 'Man of the Match' in the section provided on the return sheet.
- J It is a League requirement that all junior teams must be accompanied by a 'responsible adult'
- K The wicket keeper shall wear a helmet, or ECB approved face mask at all at all times irrespective of whether he/she is standing up to the stumps
- L The pitch shall measure 22yds
- M Result sheets must be returned without delay to the appointed person within 72hrs.
- N In the event of a points tie for the League Championship, a play off shall be arranged
- O Should a club register two teams in the same age group, each player must be registered to only one team, and will not be permitted to play for the other during the season, except in an 'outside' cup competition where one team will be the sole representative of that club
- P The winner of the League's Under 15s League Cup will represent the 'The Durham Coast Cricket League' in the ECB's National Club Championship.
- Q Female players may participate up to two years above the age grouping
- U Coaching from the boundry by Team Managers for Under 15s is not permitted

Under 15s Rules.

- 1 To be eligible to participate in Under 15s cricket, a player must be under 15yrs on Sept 1st of the previous year. In the case of a female player 17yrs on Sept 1st of the previous year
- 2 It is a League requirement, that all clubs must ensure a parental consent form is completed for all junior players
- 3 Bowling restrictions, No bowler is to bowl more than 4 overs
- 4 A batter reaching 50 runs shall retire and will not be permitted to return.
- 5 ECB Fielding and Bowling regulations will apply
- 6 For issues that are not covered by the above please refer to the League handbook which will come into effect
