

DURHAM COAST CRICKET LEAGUE.
JUNIOR DIVISIONS MATCH ARRANGEMENTS.

- A] The Durham Coast Cricket League fully endorses and complies with the ECB_Child Welfare Policy known as Safe Hands;
- B] Membership shall be open to all, irrespective of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, creed, colour, social status, or sexual orientation.
- C] The Durham Coast Cricket League recognises that it has a duty of care for the young people playing within the League. Therefore, it insists that all junior wicket keepers whether standing up, or back, must wear a helmet and that the current ECB fielding restrictions will apply.
- D] Yearly Subscriptions, shall be £20 per club and should be paid to the Junior Divisions Treasurer on, or before April 1st each year.
- E] All result sheets including abandoned fixtures should be received by the relevant person within 72 hours of the fixture.
- F] All non returned, incomplete, or late result sheets will receive an imposed fine.
£5-00 Non Returned
£3-00 Late/Incomplete.
- G] A Non fulfilment of a fixture will be dealt with by the League Executive.
- H] All matches will be played on the date and time appointed in the League Handbook.
- I] Umpiring of 11s/13s/15s/fixtures should be done so by an adult.
- J] It is a requirement that junior players must be registered before the season commences with the Junior Divisions Secretary.
- K] Following the completion of each fixture, it is the responsibility of each Captain to complete, and forward the oppositions Man of the Match nomination.
- L] It is a requirement that all Junior teams are accompanied by a responsible adult.
- M] Junior players registered with the Durham Coast Cricket League are not permitted to play for another club in any other Junior League during that current season, unless, a transfer request has been received by the League Secretary
- N] All clubs must ensure, that each young person's parent/carer completes and signs the Club Registration Document.
- O] All clubs are required to complete the Child Protection Procedure documentation and return to the League Welfare Officer, before the commencement of the season
- P] All discipline matters will be dealt with by the Full League Executive.
